- 1.0 *Indradhanush* starts with a dance based on a Hindi prayer, “*Itni Shakti Hame Dena Data*” by the special children of our organization. Through this dance they will pray to the Lord on behalf of all of us to give us mental strength and confidence.

- 2.0 Then our budding singers and instrumentalists will be on the stage. First, the singers will present a song “*Jhula Dalo Ambua Ki Daali*” based on Raag “*Vrindavani Sarang*” with *Alaap* and *Taan*.

- 3.0 Then the tiny tots will take the audience to a starry night with their song, “*Tim Tim Tim Tim Neel Gagan Mein Taare*”.

- 4.0 After that little instrumentalists will present *Surtarang* based on Raag *Durga* and *Tin Taal* and *Jhamp Taal*.

Casio: *Rashi, Manik, Divyansh and Aditya. Tabla: Shikhar and Aditya.*

- 5.0 After the musicians the budding Odissi dancers will begin with “*Mangalacharana*” where the artists dedicate themselves to the Almighty and plead forgiveness from the Mother Earth for stamping feet on her, beg apology from the audience for any shortcomings and pay obeisance to their Guru. In *Mangalacharana*, the artists will present “*Namami Vighna Raja Twam*,” a prayer to Lord Ganesha, the destroyer of all obstacles.

- 6.0 The next dance item will be “*Shiva Tandava*” written by Ravana, the demon king of Lanka in which the “*Udhata or Rudra*” manifestation of Lord Shiva is depicted.

- 7.0 Then comes an *Abhinaya*, based on an Oriya song “*Kanhi Gale Murali Phunka*” in which Radha is searching for Lord Krishna who always flirts with other Gopis by playing his musical flute and troubles them with his naughtiness and pranks.

- 8.0 The second dance item will be “*Pallavi*” based on *Raag Vasanta*. It is a pure dance item. The movements of this item are extremely graceful and lyrical.

- 9.0 The next item based on Oriya song, “*Radha Rani Sange Nache Murali Pani*” based on an Oriya song will be presented by the little dancers in which the *Raas Leela* of Lord Krishna and Radha will be depicted.

- 10.0 The last item of the Odissi repertoire of the evening will be “*Moksha*” in which the dancers will pray to the Almighty for world peace and universal prosperity.

- 11.0 After the classical dance performances our tiny tots will show the audience how to enjoy the showers of monsoon by tapping their feet rhythmically to the tune of “*Chak Dhum Dhum.*”
