8. "Batu" which is a Nritta or pure dance, depicts different sculptural postures of ancient temples of Orissa. This item is devoid of lyric and there is no Bhava-Abhinaya or expression

9. The next item will be Shiva Tandava in which the dancers will not only pray Lord Shiva for His blessings but also depict the Rudra Bhava or anger aspect of Lord Shiva.
