Association for Learning Performing Arts & Normative Action (A.L.P.A.N.A.) was launched in 2003 as a registered Society in the National Capital Territory of Delhi. During sixteen years, A.L.P.A.N.A. has made significant contribution to its espoused cause of spreading awareness among today's youth about the rich cultural heritage of India, especially Odissi Dance, Vocal and Instrumental Music.

Presently, A.L.P.A.N.A. Institute has more than 140 students including 42 Divyang students, pursuing programmes in classical dance, folk dance, vocal music, instrumental music, painting, sculpting and vocational crafts in three Centres. The Institute is a recognized training and examination centre of the Akhila Bharatiya Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mandal, Maharashtra.

Every year A.L.P.A.N.A. organises INDRADHANUSH, a unique platform where Divyang students (students with Disabilities) and other students perform together on the same stage; SAMBHAV, an International event to showcase the artistic and creative talents of Divyangjan (persons with Disabilities) from all over the world, BHOOMI PRANAM where A.L.P.A.N.A. launches its qualified students on professional platform and Rangotsav, an Art & Craft workshop for Divyangjan with a focus on environmental issues expressed through art and craft.

In May, 2012 Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (DUSIB) allotted a Basti Vikas Kendra (BVK) at Kalyanpuri, East Delhi where A.L.P.A.N.A. conducts Vocational training programmes and different skill development programmes and also training in Dance and Music to disadvantaged participants including Divyang students. Every year exhibitions of products made by trainees are held at different places of Delhi and NCR and also at INTEGRATION 2018, Muscov and Art for All Conference, Thailand.

Diyas and candles



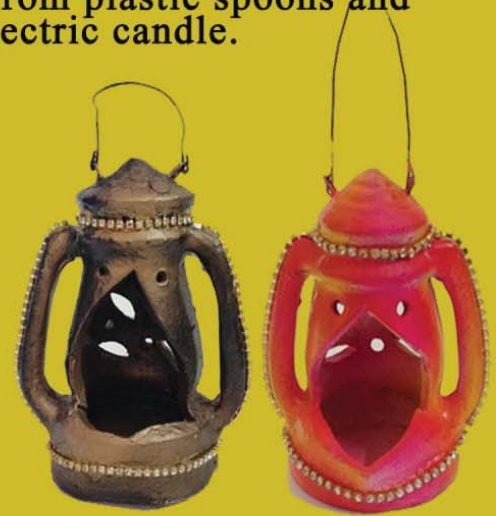
Terracotta Diyas: These handmade decorative diyas are created from terracotta and waste materials. They can be used with oil/wax/gel/tea light candles. These are hand decorated and come in different shapes, such as leaf, camel, tortoise, lotus, shankha (conch shell), etc.





Lotus Diya – This is made from plastic spoons and can hold a tea light wax/gel/electric candle.

Lantern – This environment friendly product is created from clay, hand painted and decorated with stones. It can be either placed on a table or hung on a wall. The bronze lantern comes in two sizes i.e., small and medium; and two colour variants i.e., metallic bronze and multicolour.



Matki Diya – This reusable diya/lamp is created from clay, hand painted with acrylic colours and decorated with stones. A tea light wax/gel/electric candle could be placed in the diya and the product can be used for room or festival decoration.





Lighting Glasses: These decorative pieces are made by reusing glasses with a cardboard base. They are hand-painted and can be used as room decoration. This product is available in several colors and sizes.





Decorated Bottle Lamps: These products demonstrate recycling at its best as these are made from used glass bottles. These are decorated with hand paintings, beads and stones. They can be used as decorative table lamps. This product is available in several colours and sizes.





Papier Mache Artifacts – These products demonstrate recycling at its best as these are made from waste paper with Papier Mache technique. These are hand painted and decorated with stones, and comes in different sizes and shapes.



MDF Dry Fruit Tray – This product is made from medium density fiberboard (MDF) which is one of the most sustainable engineered woods. It comes in a tray consisting of either 2 containers or 4 containers.

Bandhanwar

MDF Bandhanwar – These bandhanwars are hand-made from medium density fiber-board (MDF) blocks. MDF makes this product durable.



Cloth-based Bandhanwar – These bandhanwars are made from waste fabric which is decorated with lace, stones and decorative hangings.

Bead-strings Bandhanwar – Made from reusable bead-strings and stone decoration, this bandhanwar is durable, economical with traditional aesthetics.

Ceramic Bandhanwar – The base material for this bandhanwar is ceramic, an environment friendly material.





Multi-purpose Holders: These holders are meticulously created from waste materials, such as jute rope, plastic container, cardboard, etc. The variants include triple holder with stone decorations, hand-painted portrait holder, decorated with stones, jute rope-based holders





Aarti Thal – These are made from waste steel plates decorated with ceramic work, acrylic paint, lace, pom-pom, stones, mirror-work, etc. The variants come in several traditional designs.





Lakshmi-Ganesh Idols – The idols are made of terracotta decorated with stone-work. They come in 2 sizes, i.e., 5-inch and 3-inch.



Lakshmi Charan – This product comes in both terracotta and MDF variants. They are specially used in puja occasions. The terracotta pair contains 2 small containers to be used as diyas. They are reusable as can be wiped clean with a cloth after use. The MDF lakshmi charan pair is multicoloured, decorated with stones. This type comes in 2 variants.





Rangoli – A beautiful selection of intricate rangoli designs in MDF embellishments are best suited for festive and wedding season. The MDF cut-outs make the rangoli durable and open to the possibilities of various decorative ideas.

Wooden Candle Holder - The hand painted candle holders are made from MDF. They can be used with a white or coloured tea light to create soothing and peaceful ambiance. They add an elegant element to traditional as well as contemporary Indian homes. The tea light candles can be replaced after every use.





Paintings – The range of traditional and contemporary art includes acrylic and mixed media paintings. These paintings are perfect for gifts as well as home decor to add to the aesthetics of any room.

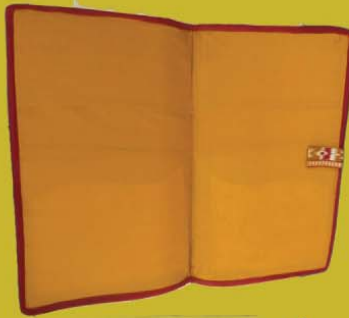
